Information on redemption exemption procedures for emergency small-lot

 \sim Regarding redemption exemptions other than residence tax exemption \sim

If the emergency small-lot funds/general support funds (special loans) that you borrowed meet the Requirements set by the government after redemption (repayment) has begun, they may be exempted from redemption (no repayment required). Details and procedures for redemption exemptions other than residence tax exemption I'll let you know about it.

1 Requirements for redemption exemption (other than residence tax exemption) and documents required for application, etc.

O Regarding the requirements of 1~3 and 6 of 1 above, the decision to exempt the redemption will be made after the start of redemption.
