

**Information on redemption exemption procedures for emergency small-lot
funds and general support funds (special loans)**

~Regarding redemption exemptions other than residence tax exemption~

If the emergency small-lot funds/general support funds (special loans) that you borrowed meet the Requirements set by the government after redemption (repayment) has begun, they may be exempted from redemption (no repayment required). Details and procedures for redemption exemptions other than residence tax exemption I'll let you know about it.

1 Requirements for redemption exemption (other than residence tax exemption) and documents required for application, etc.

The requirements are that the lessee meets the following requirements.

	Requirements (borrower)	Required documents
1	If you receive public assistance	① Redemption exemption application form ② Certificate of welfare receipt or notification of welfare receipt decision
2	When a mental health welfare notebook (grade 1) is issued	① Redemption exemption application form ② Copy of mental health welfare notebook (grade 1)
3	If a physical disability certificate (1st or 2nd grade) or rehabilitation certificate (A judgment) has been issued.	① Redemption exemption application form ② A copy of a physical disability certificate (1st or 2nd grade) or a rehabilitation certificate (A grade)
4	If dead	Deletion of resident record or death certificate
5	If declared missing	Documents certifying that the declaration of disappearance has been finalized
6	If all of the following requirements are met, only the amount that cannot be redeemed and is in arrears since the start of redemption will be exempted from redemption.	
	① There are amounts that have not been redeemed for more than 12 months <u>from the start of redemption.</u> ② I am repaying my debt through installment payments and small redemptions, but the amount that I have not been able to redeem is increasing. ③ Tenants and heads of households are subject to resident tax in a per capita rate only. (<u>Resident tax income tax exempt</u>) ④ A household that falls into one of the following categories I. Households with only elderly people (Over 65 years old) II. Disabled household (Possession of a disability certificate) III. Single parent household	① Redemption exemption application form ② Resident records for all members of the household ※Items with a description of the head of household and relationship ※Issued within 3 months from the time of application for exemption ※Items without My Number written on them ※Items that say "all household members" ③ Taxation certificate or tax exemption certificate for the year in which you apply for exemption (Those of the tenant and the head of household) ※Documents that can confirm residence tax income deduction ④ If ④- I on the left applies, a copy of the document that confirms that you are a household with a disability.

※The requirements in 6 above are based on the situation after a certain period of time has passed after the start of redemption.

2 Regarding applications for redemption (repayment) exemption, etc. and points to keep in mind

- If you meet the above requirements, please contact us by phone.
- Amounts that have already been redeemed (repaid) before the redemption exemption decision is made are not eligible for redemption exemption.
- Regarding the requirements of 1~3 and 6 of 1 above, the decision to exempt the redemption will be made after the start of redemption.

【How to apply】Please send the application for exemption from reimbursement (which will be sent by the Society after receiving a telephone contact) and the necessary documents to the "Contact Information" below.

【Bear in mind】If you have more than one loan, you will need to submit an application for forgiveness for each loan, but for other confirmation documents, you will be required to submit the Only when applying, one copy is sufficient.
